# Community




Geography, Functions, Identity;

The whole and the parts interact through community participation, leadership and process.






#### **School community**



### Community health




**Dynamic process of community empowerment** in which community participation, process and leadership combine in the ability to identify and solve problems and leverage community resources.

Community health determinants interrelate the improvement of public health determinants with community empowerment indicators, enhancing the effectiveness of community intervention in a collaborative perspective.


# Community Nursing Care



Development of a **collaborative action that empowers the community,** underpinning the approach of community management as an enhancer of gains in community health sensitive to nursing care.

It integrates the approach of **community empowerment as a process**, in the integrated and integrative vision of the community as a whole **and as a result** of empowering the community to reach the maximum level of community empowerment.






The aim of nurses' care is the community, approached as a care unit, framing the whole and the parts of the community, in a dynamic and continuous process of community empowerment.



The Nurse, as an external agent, promoter of community empowerment, must work in partnership with community members and leaders towards their autonomy in solving their problems.



Community nursing care enhances the areas **that facilitate its empowerment**, promoting the optimization of community resources and skills.



Considering Health Planning as a methodological principle, nurses must assess the health status of all communities for which they are responsible, ensuring the inclusion of all assessments in their prioritization processes.

The community approach is developed both in the context of empowering community health and from the perspective of empowering public health.


The relationship between the assessment of the health status of the community and the characteristics of the community environment, allow identifying the planning of interventions adjusted to the needs of the community.

The community, as a care unit, requires nursing interventions in order to enhance responses in community empowerment as a process and as a result.




